## Important Dates - Fall 2023

Date(s)	Important Deadlines
8/18	University residence halls open Last day a graduate student may register in absentia
8/21	First Day of Classes
8/24	Last day to add a class without permission. <i>*After this date, changes in registration may require approval of the Department Chair and College Dean.</i>
8/25	Withdrawal, student to receive <b>80% refund.</b>
9/1	Withdrawal, student to receive <b>70% refund.</b>
9/5	Labor Day Holiday, No classes held
9/6	12 <sup>th</sup> Class Day, the date of official enrollment taken; Last day for undergraduate students to drop a class <i>*without permission;</i> Last day to drop a class for a possible refund.
9/11	Withdrawal, student to receive <b>50% refund.</b>
9/18	Withdrawal, student to receive <b>25% refund.</b> <i>*After this date, student to receive 0% refund.</i> <i>*After this date, if a student is on scholastic probation and withdraws, student will be automatically dismissed.</i>
10/23	Last day an <b>undergraduate</b> student may <u>withdraw</u> from the University or <u>drop</u> a class (with Dean's approval), including <u>Q drops</u> through College, and CLR applications through Disability and Access; Last day undergraduate students can change class to/from pass/fail basis; Last day to apply for an undergraduate degree. <i>*After this date, student can submit medical and mental health withdrawal application (if any <b>new incidents</b> occur <b>after</b> this deadline), with supporting documentation required. Completed application must be submitted to Services for Students with Disabilities (SSD), SSB 4.206.</i>
10/30 – 11/10	Current student registration period for spring semester.
11/17	Last day to apply for a graduate degree.
	Last day for <u>resident</u> students to apply for Late Course Load Reduction (late CLR) through Disability and Access.
11/20	Last day <b>graduate</b> students can change class to or from credit/no credit basis
11/20 – 11/25	Fall break/Thanksgiving; no classes held
12/4	Last Day of Classes for Fall Term; Last day a <b>graduate</b> student may <u>withdraw</u> from the University or <u>drop</u> a class (with Dean's approval), including <u>Q drops</u> through College; Last day students can submit <u>medical and mental health withdrawal</u> application. Last day for <u>international</u> students to apply for late course load reduction, with supporting documentation required. <i>Completed application must be submitted to Disability and Access, SSB 4.206.</i> <i>*After this date, student can submit retroactive withdrawal appeal for non-academic reasons, to be reviewed by the student's College Dean's Office. Documentation must include verification of inability to have withdrawn by prior deadlines.</i>
December 7-9 & 11	Final Exams
December 11-15	Spring 2024 registration for continuing and readmitted students
December 12	Residence halls close at 9:00 a.m. (except for graduating students).
December 16	Official graduation date (No public exercises)
