

GM, Chevrolet, Pontiac, Saturn, Chrysler, Mazda, Ford, Toyota, and Lexus are Recalling Vehicles for Safety and Mechanical Problems

GM, Chevrolet, Pontiac & Saturn Recalled Vehicles

Recalled GM vehicles include:

- All 2005-2010 Chevrolet Cobalt
- 2005-2007 Pontiac G5
- 2003-2007 Saturn Ion
- 2006-2011 Chevrolet HHR
- 2006-2010 Pontiac Solstice
- 2007-2010 Saturn Sky

Chrysler Recalled Vehicles

Chrysler is recalling Jeep Grand Cherokee and Dodge Durango SUVs from the 2011 through 2014 model because corrosion may make the vehicles' brakes harder to use. Chrysler began investigating after some customers said their brakes felt too firm when pressed down. The company knows of one accident, but no injuries, due to the defect. Chrysler will notify owners of the recall, which involves 867,795 vehicles.

Mazda Recalled Vehicles

Mazda models built between 2010 and 2012 and equipped with the 2.5-liter four-cylinder engine are being recalled because of spiders in vent lines.

So far, Mazda has not recorded any fires, accidents or injuries due to this tangled mess of webs. Recall notices will be mailed out to owners later this month.

Ford Recalled Vehicles

Ford is recalling Ford Escapes from the 2001 through 2004 model years. Ford says the subframes can rust, allowing a control arm to separate and hamper steering control. Ford is aware of one crash but no injuries linked to the problem.

Ford is also recalling 49,000 Ford Fusion, Lincoln MKZ, Ford Escape and C-MAX vehicles from 2013 and 2014. Dealers will replace seat back frames that weren't welded properly. No crashes or injuries have been reported from the problem, Ford said.

Toyota & Lexus Recalled Vehicles

Toyota is recalling 2003-2004 Avalon sedans, 2010-2014 Prius vehicles, 2012 RAV4, 2012-2013 Tacoma, and 2012-2013 Lexus RX 350 vehicles sold in the United States to address two separate issues.

In the involved Toyota Avalon vehicles, certain circuits within the airbag control module may be susceptible to damage if exposed to electrical noise from other electrical components. In some instances, front airbag(s) and/or seat belt pre-tensioners could inadvertently deploy.

The Prius software's current settings could result in higher thermal stress in certain transistors, potentially causing them to become damaged. If this happens, various warning lights will illuminate and the vehicle can enter a failsafe mode. In rare circumstances, the hybrid system might shut down while the vehicle is being driven, resulting in the loss of power and the vehicle coming to a stop.

Toyota will update the skid control ECU software on certain 2012 Toyota RAV4, 2012-2013 Toyota Tacoma, and 2012-2013 Lexus RX 350 models in order to address an electronic circuit condition that can cause the Vehicle Stability Control, Anti-lock Brake, and Traction Control functions to intermittently turn off. If these systems are off, standard braking operation remains fully functional.

Toyota has received no reports of accidents or injuries associated with either condition.
