ON-CAMPUS TESTING: Placement tests and credit by examination are offered August 19–27, 2009. CLASS REGISTRATION: Any new and readmitted students who are not yet registered are eligible to register Thursday, August 20, and Friday, August 21, 2009. To complete registration, tuition/fee bills must be paid no later than 5 p.m. on August 25, 2009.

UNIVERSITY RESIDENCE HALLS open for the fall semester on Friday, August 21 at 9 a.m. Early check-in begins on Tuesday, August 18, at 4 p.m. No one will be allowed to check in to a fall assignment before this time. Students must schedule their check-in times on the Housing Web site at www.utexas.edu/student/housing/ by August 15. If a check-in time is not scheduled, there is no guarantee that rooms will be ready upon arrival. Students checking in early will be billed an additional room charge of \$50 per person, per night.
