Important Dates - Spring 2021

| Date(s) | Important Deadlines |

| 1/17 | Student-initiated course cancellations and withdrawals (prior to first class day), student to receive 100% refund . |
| 1/18 | MLK Holiday |
| 1/19 | First Day of Classes |
| 1/22 | Last day of the official add/drop period. <i>*After this date, changes in registration may require approval of the Department Chair and College Dean.</i> |
| 1/25 | Withdrawal, student to receive 80% refund . |
| 2/1 | Withdrawal, student to receive 70% refund . |
| 2/3 | 12 th Class Day, the date of official enrollment taken; Last day for students to add a class <i>*except for rare and extenuating circumstances;</i> Last day to drop a class for a possible refund. |
| 2/8 | Withdrawal, student to receive 50% refund . |
| 2/15 | Withdrawal, student to receive 25% refund . <i>*After this date, student to receive 0% refund.</i> <i>*After this date, if a student is on scholastic probation and withdraws, student will be automatically dismissed.</i> |
| 3/15- 3/20 | Spring Break |
| 3/29 | Last day to apply for a law degree. |
| 4/5 | Last day an undergraduate student may <u>withdraw</u> from the University or <u>drop</u> a class (with Dean's approval), including <u>Q drops</u> through College; Last day undergraduate students can change class to/from pass/fail basis; Last day to apply for an undergraduate degree. <i>*After this date, student can submit medical and mental health withdrawal application (if any new incidents occur after this deadline), with supporting documentation required. Completed application must be submitted to Services for Students with Disabilities (SSD), SSB 4.206.</i> |
| 4/16 | Last day to apply for a graduate degree. |
| 4/19- 4/30 | Current student registration period for summer session and fall semester. |
| 4/26 | Last day graduate students can change class to or from credit/no credit basis |
| 4/30 | Last day a law student may <u>withdraw</u> from the University or <u>drop</u> a class (with Dean's approval). |
| 5/7 | Last Day of Classes; Last day a graduate student may <u>withdraw</u> from the University or <u>drop</u> a class (with Dean's approval), including <u>Q drops</u> through College; Last day students can submit <u>medical and mental health withdrawal</u> application or course load reduction, with supporting documentation required. <i>Completed application must be submitted to Services for Students with Disabilities (SSD), SSB 4.206.</i> <i>*After this date, student can submit retroactive withdrawal appeal for non-academic reasons, to be reviewed by the student's College Dean's Office. Documentation must include verification of inability to have withdrawn by prior deadlines.</i> |
| 5/11 | Last day an undergraduate, with the required approvals, may request a non-academic Q drop |
| 5/12-18 | Final Exams |
| 5/21-22 | Graduation Ceremonies and Commencement |
| 5/28 | Last day undergraduate students may submit requests for their total of three (3) classes graded on a Pass/Fail basis (COVID-19 Pass/Fail Exception) without penalty for fall 2020 and spring 2021 |
