



Institutional Rules (Sec. 6-204) requires that “Only a sponsored student organization may use the name of the University or an abbreviation of the name of the University or any of the University’s trademarks or service marks as part of or in conjunction with its student organization name. Sponsorship may not be extended to registered student organizations involved in political or religious activities or in projects for private gain. Legislative student organizations must be officially sponsored by the University. No student, unregistered group, or registered student, faculty, or staff organization may use the name of the University or an abbreviation of the name of the University as part of its name. A student, group, or organization may use terms such as “campus” or “Texas campus” or [name of organization] at the University of Texas at Austin as part of its name. No student, unregistered group, or registered student, faculty, or staff organization may advertise or promote any event or activity in a manner that falsely suggests that the event or activity is sponsored by the University.”
