The official timeline for the 2018 First-Year Representative Election indicates that all candidates must submit their third, full and complete disclosure of campaign finances prior to 4:30 PM on September 26th, 2018. This information was communicated to all candidates at the mandatory candidate seminar on September 18th, 2018. In addition to the seminar, all candidates were reminded via email the day of the disclosure.

In accordance with Advisory Opinion #2 in Fall 2018 and the presentation that was delivered at the candidate seminar on September 18th, all candidates who fail to submit their third financial disclosure prior to its deadline will have a Class D violation levied against them and receive a disqualification from the race.

The candidates who failed to submit the third and last financial disclosure in a timely manner in as follows:

This Court finds a hearing on this matter to be unnecessary due to the lack of question of fact and explicitly laid out sanction for this transgression.

Pursuant to Advisory Opinion #2 in Fall 2018, all candidates listed above shall receive a Class D violation and a disqualification from the First-Year Representative elections.

It is so ordered.
