On September 26, 2017, the Court heard the case of student Dora Gurfinkel v. First-Year Representative Candidate Samuel Samson. The Court appreciates the strength and passion of the arguments from both sides. Based on the complexity of the issue on hand, however, the Court needs more time to finalize an opinion. However, the Court has determined an appropriate remedy in this matter and based upon the time constraints of the First-Year Representative Elections the Court has deemed it necessary to release the remedy pending final explanation to follow soon.

The Court enjoins Candidate Sampson to correct those events on his website which have not occurred as advertised, and ensure that if any future event posting does not occur as advertised to also retroactively amend those event postings to rectify any inaccuracies.
